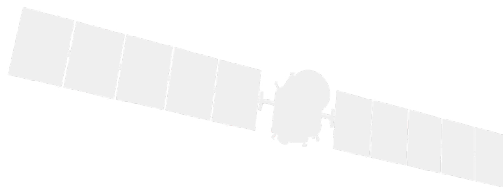
The information services provided are freely and openly accessible to its users.
